- **What:** The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo (HLSR) promotes agriculture by providing a family-friendly live entertainment experience that educates the public, supports Texas youth, and showcases Western heritage.
- **When:** February 28 – March 19, 2023

- **Where:** NRG Park, 8825 Kirby Drive, Houston, Texas 77054

- **Cost:** General Admission for adults is \$20

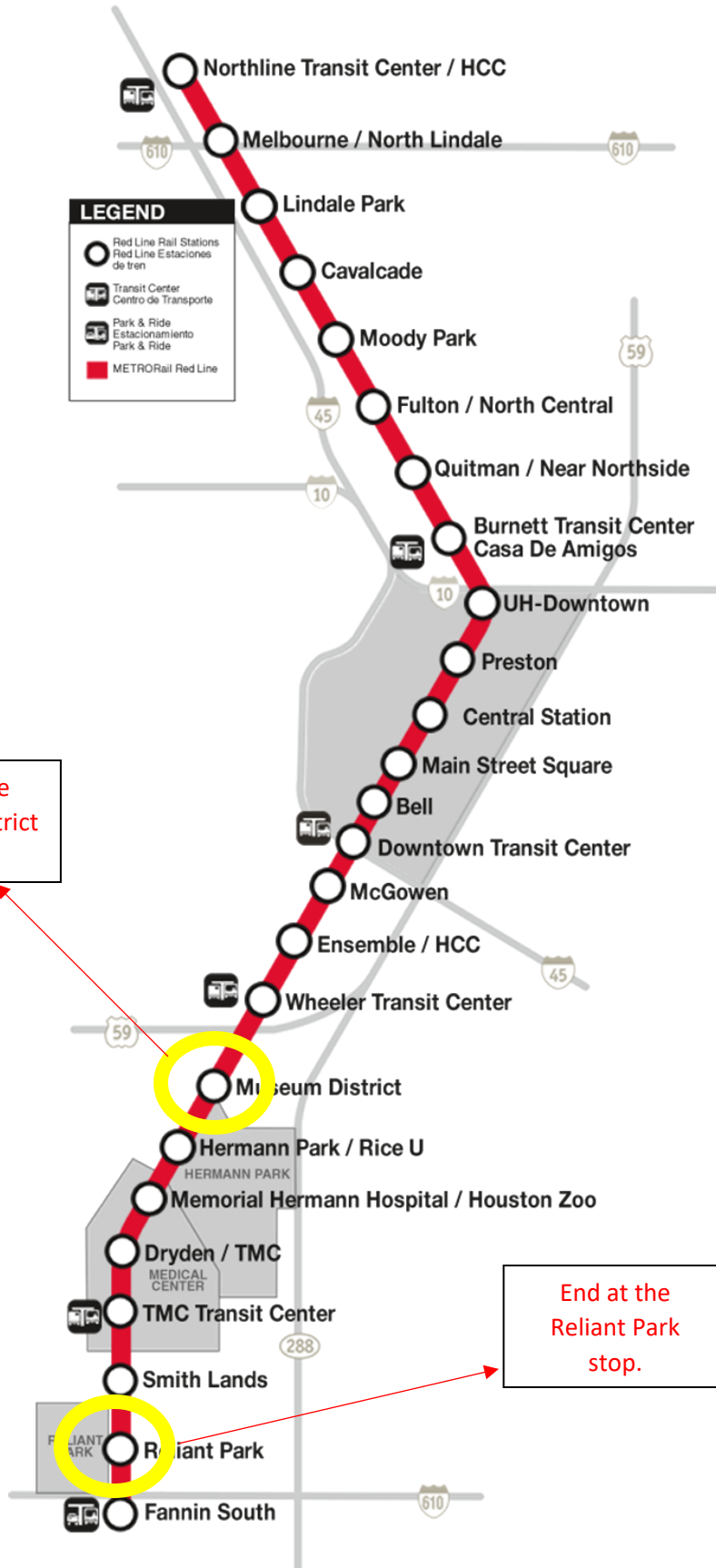
