

CAM APPLICATION PROGRAM

CAM, or the Central American Minors Program, provides qualifying parents and legal guardians in the United States who are in certain immigration categories an opportunity to apply for their qualifying children to reunify with them in the United States.

Through CAM, parents and legal guardians can apply for qualifying children and certain family members in Guatemala, El Salvador, and Honduras to travel to the United States with refugee status. Those who are not granted refugee status may be able to apply for parole.

If you or someone you know is a parent or legal guardian in the U.S. in a qualifying immigration category, with an unmarried child under 21 who is a national of and located in El Salvador, Guatemala, or Honduras, you may be eligible to apply for CAM.

The qualifying immigration categories are:

- Lawful permanent resident
- Temporary Protected Status
- Parole
(for a minimum of one year)
- Deferred action
(for a minimum of one year)
- Deferred enforced departure (DED)
- Withholding of Removal
- Pending asylum application
filed on or before April 11, 2023*
- Pending U visa petition
filed on or before April 11, 2023*
- Pending T visa petition
filed on or before April 11, 2023*

KIND can help parents and legal guardians determine if they may be eligible for CAM, and if so, to prepare their applications for the program. KIND is partnering with the International Rescue Committee (IRC) for this project.

KIND will screen your case and help you start the CAM application process if you are eligible.

*Parents and legal guardians eligible under the [CAM Enhancements](#) cannot yet file a CAM application until the U.S. Government has issued an updated version of the CAM AOR application form. Parents and legal guardians eligible under the CAM Enhancements are those with pending asylum or U visa applications filed between May 16, 2021, and April 11, 2023, as well as those with pending T visa applications filed on or before April 11, 2023.
