The questions below will equip you to assess elected officials' and candidates' dedication to safeguarding unaccompanied children, advocating for child-centered policies, and endorsing initiatives such as KIND's Keeping Kids Safe Campaign and the Immigration Court Efficiency and Children's Court Act of 2023 (S.3178/H.R.6145). You can use these questions in your interactions at town halls, meetings with policymakers, and candidate forums to gauge their support for these crucial issues.

Do you agree that unaccompanied children are children first and we should focus on their need for safety?

Do you agree that there are bipartisan solutions to protect unaccompanied children?

Do you agree that all children should have access to education and other services they need to succeed?

Do you agree that policy makers should set aside partisan politics to find solutions for protecting unaccompanied children?







Asking these questions at public events will also help ensure that candidates are held accountable and prioritize the well-being of children once in office.
